The 2025 Tour will be run in the same efficient manner, whilst maintaining the friendly atmosphere which makes an event even more enjoyable.

Participants will enjoy a leisurely drive in picturesque countryside along roads best enjoyed at a slower pace, giving both driver and passenger/s longer to enjoy the glorious views and features provided by the Powys and Gwynedd scenery. A lunch halt will be provided on the tour where participants will have time to enjoy a picnic lunch or purchase food. In addition, morning coffee and afternoon tea rest halts will be included.

You will also receive a commemorative souvenir.

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

- The Kidderminster Motor Car Club Limited will organise "The Hills and Valley Scenic Tour" on Sunday 18 May 2025 starting and finishing at the Welshpool Livestock Sales, Buttington Cross, Welshpool, SY21 8SR. Map reference: 126/2425 0880.
- The meeting will be held under the National Competition Rules of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.
- 3. Motorsport UK Certificate of Exemption No. 201483 has been issued for this touring assembly.
- 4. The event is open to fully elected members of Kidderminster Motor Car Club Limited, members of the Historic Rally Car Register and members of other Clubs who have accepted an invitation to participate. In addition, members of the public are welcome to participate (Chapter 3 App.7 Art.1.2).
- 5. All drivers must produce a valid driving licence for the vehicle being driven at signing on. A competition licence is not required. All drivers must ensure that they have adequate insurance to enter the event and the entry form contains a declaration to this effect that the driver must sign. This touring assembly has no competitive element.
- The Hills and Valley Scenic Tour is included in the Historic Rally Car Register's Scenic Tour Series 2025 kindly supported by 'Monit Motorsport' (www.monitmotorsport.com) and 'Peter James Insurance' (www.peter jamesinsurance.co.uk).
- 7. The event is open to all three and four wheeled passenger road vehicles. All vehicles must hold a V5 registration document and, as necessary, have a valid MOT certificate, which must be available for inspection. It is the responsibility of each participant to ensure that his/her vehicle is roadworthy and is currently taxed for use on the public highway.
- 8. The event is a touring assembly and will comprise a scenic drive through Powys and Gwynedd covering approximately 120 miles on sealed surface public roads of various classes. The route will be split into four sections and will be described in a road book and identified by 'tulip' style navigational diagrams at specified mileages.

The road book will also contain written descriptions of junctions and information about places of interest and features along the route. Some suitable stopping places will be indicated where you may wish to spend a few minutes enjoying the scenery.

- The programme of the event will be as follows: Signing on will take place on Sunday 18 May from 08:00. The first car will start at 09:15.
 The finish will be from approximately 16:15.
- 10. The entry list opens on publication of these Supplementary Regulations and closes finally on Monday 12 May 2025. The entry fee will be £110.00. The entry fee will include breakfast, morning and afternoon refreshments and evening buffet and commemorative souvenir for the driver and one passenger. Additional passengers are permitted at a cost of £35.00 each which includes breakfast, rest halt refreshments and evening buffet.
- 11. Entries can be made using the online Google form on the Club website or by completing the event entry form which should be sent either by post to Sheila Roath, Entries Secretary, 72 Willowfield Drive, Kidderminster, Worcs, DY11 5DP or by email to kiddicarclub@blueyonder.co.uk. The entry fee may be paid by cheque, made payable to "Kidderminster Motor Car Club Ltd" or by a BACS payment. Please contact the Entries Secretary for the necessary account details. Entries will not be accepted by telephone.
- 12. The maximum entry for the meeting, excluding reserves, is 65. The minimum is 40. Should the above minimum figure not be reached, the organisers have the right to cancel the event, in which case, the full entry fee will be refunded. Entry fees may also be refunded, less an administration fee of £20.00 per entry, if written cancellation of the entry is received by the Entries Secretary on or before the closing date for receipt of entries. Refunds after this date will be at the organisers' discretion.
- 13. Entries will be selected in order of receipt and the running order will be decided by the organisers. If an entrant wishes to run close to a friend/colleague, this should be indicated by completing the relevant section on the entry form.
- 14. Acknowledgement of entries will be sent by email where possible, or by post. Final instructions and provisional entry list will be sent to the driver either by email or post during the week prior to the event.

- 15. Participants will be supplied with the following at signing on: road book; final entry list; vehicle tour plate; refreshment vouchers and your allocated start time. Official notices may be displayed at signing on and every participant will be deemed to have read such notices.
- 16. Participants' vehicles will be identified by scenic tour plates supplied by the organisers. The tour plate shall be displayed in a prominent forward facing position on the vehicle.
- 17. The tour will include a number of pre-arranged points including: Start - participants will start at one minute intervals at their allocated start times. It is the participant's responsibility to have completed signing on sufficiently early to achieve the start time. The start time will be recorded on your 'Proof of Passage Card' and verified by a marshal's signature.

Intermediate and Lunch (In) - participants will have a suggested due time, based on the estimated event time schedule, at which they should arrive. Proof of passage will be recorded by a marshal's signature on your 'Proof of Passage Card'.

Lunch (Out) - participants will start at one minute intervals at their allocated start times previously nominated at Lunch (In). The start time will be recorded on your 'Proof of Passage Card' and verified by a marshal's signature.

Finish - participants will have a suggested due time, based on the estimated event time schedule, at which they should arrive. Proof of passage will be recorded by a marshal's signature on your 'Proof of Passage Card'.

Secret Check - these checks may be located at points along the route not specified to participants but identified by a preceding board. They provide confirmation only that participants are on the correct route. Proof of passage will be recorded by a marshal's signature on your 'Proof of Passage Card'.

Pre-arranged points will be manned from the suggested due time of the first car until ten minutes after the suggested due time of the last car, based on the estimated event time schedule. These time windows have been calculated on cars achieving not more than 25 miles per hour average speed. All pre-arranged points will be preceded by a warning board and a sample board will be on display at signing on. All watches will be set to BBC time and an official watch will be on display at signing on.

The information regarding pre-arranged points is provided for the guidance of participants only and, is suggested for the purpose of preventing participants travelling too fast or too slow, in accordance with Motorsport UK NCR Chapter 3 App.7 Art.1.3a. However, there is **NO** mandatory requirement for participants to comply with the information provided, i.e. visiting pre-arranged points, obtaining marshals' signatures or, adhering to the suggested due times, in accordance with Motorsport UK NCR Chapter I App.1 – Touring Assembly.

18. You may present your completed 'Proof of Passage Card' at the Finish Point. Participants will receive a commemorative souvenir for the driver and one passenger.

Judges of Fact, appointed by the organisers, will be on duty throughout the event to observe on driving standards and report any participant driving in a manner likely to bring the event and motoring in general into disrepute. All Named Officials and Marshals, signed on for the event, will be Judges of Fact.
- 21. The welfare of children is paramount and KMCC complies with the recommendations of the Motorsport UK Policy Statement on Child Protection. Should you have any concerns relating to child welfare during this event, please contact our Child Protection Officer.
- 22. By participating on the Hills & Valley Scenic Tour participants agree to follow the values of the Motorsport UK's Respect Code which ensures Respect; Integrity; Fair Play; Self-Control and Good Manners.
- 23. Organisers mileages will be deemed to be correct.
- 24. Participants may like to follow the route which is contained on Ordnance Survey Landranger Maps 125,126, and 136. However, the road book will supply all the necessary information needed to successfully complete the Hills and Valley Scenic Tour.

- 25. Intending participants who are not members of a motor club but are interested in motorsport may wish to join Kidderminster Motor Car Club. Information and a membership application form are included in these regulations.
